






ABOUT OUR AREA













House Rules



The best spot for tacos and creative cocktails.





Things to do

Just a Stone's Throw Away: Explore Local Attractions and Activities



ADAMS NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

A must see! There are three main sites that feel like you are truly traveling back in time. You will enjoy learning all about John Adams and his descendants. Make sure to make reservations on recreation.gov. The tours only cost \$1 but you will need an entrance pass that's \$15. Open Wednesday - Sunday 9am to 5pm



MARINA BAY

Marina Bay is a scenic boardwalk with many restaurant options, including Reelhouse Marina Bay. The views of the marina and boats make for a great spot to stroll and watch the sunset.



BLUE HILLS TRAILS

Great hiking spot! There are 125 miles of trails that will take you over hills, through marshes, across meadows, and more. Make sure you bring a trail map. You can buy one at Reservation Headquarters or at the Blue Hills Trailside Museum. The skyline trail is considered a hard trail but if up for the challenge the views will not disappoint.



UNITED STATES NAVAL SHIPBUILDING MUSEUM & THE USS SALEM


Quincy's history comes to life aboard this Cold War-era heavy cruiser. Enjoy exhibits of memorabilia of over 100 U.S. Naval Cruisers including the City's namesake U.S.S. Quincy and U.S.S. Newport News.



QUINCY SHORES RESERVATION

The 2.3-mile beach at Quincy Shore Reservation is popular for birding, road biking, and running, but you can enjoy some solitude during quieter times of day. Offers free parking.





Day Trips

A short drive away: Discover nearby attractions and activities easily accessible by car.



WORLDS END

A 251-acre property owned by the Trustees of Reservation located in Hingham. Trek along carriage paths toward rolling hills and rocky shorelines and discover sweeping views of the Boston skyline.



THE FREEDOM TRAIL WALKING TOUR

Take a deep dive into the history of the American Revolution on this walking tour of Boston to visit the 16 landmarks. There are multiple tours offered including a pub crawl, holiday, north end or self-guided option. See thefreedomtrail.org for ticket information.



BOSTON CRUISES


See some of the top attractions in Boston from the waterfront on a narrated sightseeing cruise. Sit back and enjoy the views with a daytime history tour of the Boston Tea Party ships or a sunset cruise where you can listen to the cannon fire of the USS Constitution, which marks the sunset each night.



QUINCY MARKET

Have an appetite for both history and local cuisine? Then step right into this historic Boston market. Across the three market buildings (Quincy Market, South Market and North Market), you can find interesting coffees, artisanal bread, fresh seafood and of course, the Boston favorites: lobster rolls, clam chowder and Boston cream pie. Located along the Freedom Trail, make a stop on the way to the New England Aquarium, Beacon Hill, or the Museum of Fine Arts.





Kids Activities

We've handpicked the best spots where imagination and play come to life, ensuring that your family's trip to Quincy will be as educational as it is entertaining.



CADDY PARK

Located at the southern end of Quincy Shores, Caddy Park has more than 15 acres of fields and marsh, as well as a play area, lookout tower, and picnic tables.



BOSTON DUCK TOURS

Hop into a duck boat—renovated World War II amphibious vehicle—for a comprehensive tour of Boston. Pass Boston Common, Quincy Market, and the Celtics' home turf at TD Garden. Then splashdown into the Charles River for a view of the city by boat. Learn all about Boston's history and landmarks as you go.




BOSTON CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Play. Explore. Learn. While there are many museums around the city, this one is a favorite with fascinating interactive exhibits. The Gallery, Science Playground, PlaySpace, and New Balance Foundation Climb are some exceptional displays that teach children more about their environment and the world.




BOSTON WHALE WATCHING CRUISE

Experience the best of New England's marine wildlife on this guided whale-watching cruise around Stellwagen Bank Sanctuary. Hop on a high-speed catamaran that gets to and from the whales in the least amount of time possible. See humpback and fin whales, plus Atlantic white-sided dolphins with the help of a naturalist guide. The on-board galley offers food and beverages for purchase during the trip






