Beach Guide

LIBBY COVE BEACH

Located just across the street, it is a quiet neighborhood favorite. Take a right out of the property, walk about 50 yards down Great Hill Road and you will find a small sandy entry point to the shore. With no public parking and limited access, this beach is essentially private to the neighborhood. An uncrowded peaceful spot to enjoy the pristine coastline- perfect for a morning coffee or evening walk by the water.

• MOTHERS BEACH

The closest public beach, 0.7 miles away, about a 10-minute walk. It is perfect spot for a relaxing day by the calming waters and easy to reach on foot or by car.

• GOOCH'S BEACH

Further down the coast, only 1.5 miles away (roughly a 5-minute drive) Gooch's beach offers a long, beautiful stretch of sandy shoreline. Since it is a popular spot it can get busy during the summer months, but worth the visit.

PARSONS BEACH

Past Gooch's Beach on the other side of the Mousam River you will find a secluded beach offering peace and serenity. Tucked within the Rachel Carson Wildlife Reserve this hidden gem features untouched coastline and a truly tranquil setting. Parking is limited so be sure to arrive early during the summer to secure a spot.

FISHING

You can fish off the beach or rocks just outside of the house. There is also a great spot at the end of Great Hill Road at the Mausam River, just a short walk from the house.

BEST SEAFOOD

Mabel's Lobster Claw

A casual, seasonal restaurant with all the staples: fried clams, lobster rolls, and its famous baked stuffed lobster. The front porch is the perfect place to soak in the warmer days of summer. Finish off your seafood feast with a slice of classic Maine blueberry pie.



BEST LIVE LOBSTERS

Port Lobster Co

A family-owned seafood market in Kennebunkport, Maine, operating since 1953. Located at 122 Ocean Avenue, it's just a short drive from 1 Atlantic Circle. The market offers fresh, live Maine lobsters, a variety of local fish, clams, mussels, and other seafood. They also provide takeout options like lobster rolls and clam chowder, and will cook your lobster at no extra charge. Port Lobster Co. is known for its quality seafood and friendly service, making it a favorite among both locals and visitors.

<u>Rachel Carson National Wildlife Refuge</u> located along 50 miles of coastline in York and Cumberland counties. Take the Bridle Path of Kennebunk to explore the part of the refuge near the Mousam River.

<u>Nature Conservancy's Kennebunk Plains</u> at 3,200 acres, the protected sandplain grassland is the largest intact example of this ecosystem in New England. Parking along Route 99 and Mcguire Road. Mostly flat to gently rolling trails.



FIRST FAMILIES KENNEBUNKPORT MUSEUM

Take in the history with a tour of the White Columns, a Kennebunkport Historical Society property. Learn all about the life and family of George H. W Bush or enjoy a mid-week concert. The properties are available for rent if hosting a gathering. See website for more details.

GARDEN STREET BOWL

a vibrant entertainment spot perfect for families, friends, or a casual date night. This modern bowling alley features candlepin bowling, a full-service bar, and a delicious menu with local favorites. AQUAHOLICS SURF SHOP

Locally owned spot that caters to both seasoned surfers and beachgoers. They offer rentals for surfboards, paddleboards, wetsuits, and more—perfect for anyone looking to catch some waves. With quality gear, expert advice, and a laid-back vibe, it's a great stop for anyone wanting to enjoy Maine's coast.



DEEP SEA FISHING AND BOAT TOURS

Nor 'easter Deep Sea Fishing

The Nor'easter offers daily deep-sea fishing trips aboard a spacious 42-foot vessel, departing from Kennebunkport. Led by Captain Mike Perkins, a USCG-licensed captain with over 200 years of family fishing experience, these trips venture 20 miles offshore to fish for haddock, pollock, cod, cusk, and hake. The \$95 per person fee includes all fishing gear, and the crew will fillet and package your catch for you to take home.

Cast-Away Fishing Charters offers private, family-friendly excursions led by Captain Niels Jacob, a seasoned USCG-licensed captain and Maine Guide. Guests can embark on half-day fishing trips targeting striped bass, bluefish, and mackerel, or opt for two-hour children's charters that include harbor tours, seal watching, lobster trap hauls, and lighthouse visits. All equipment is provided, and trips are customizable to suit individual schedules



MAINE GHOST WALKS LLC

Offers a captivating ghost tour experience in Kennebunkport, Maine. Led by knowledgeable guides, the 90-minute walking tour delves into the town's rich history, uncovering tales of spirits, hauntings, and local legends. Starting at 8 Maine Street, the tour explores haunted landmarks, including the Nonantum Resort and the Louis T. Graves Library, providing a spine-tingling glimpse into Kennebunkport's supernatural past.
